Dear Shareholder,

Thank you to everyone who returned questionnaires concerning the CARES Act money that NOK received. These surveys provided NOK with much information about the pandemic's financial impact. After considering all of your responses, NOK's Board has prepared the enclosed application which can be submitted by NOK shareholders and their descendants to reimburse the financial impact of COVID 19.

From your survey responses, we know that there are many different ways in which COVID 19 has financially impacted our shareholders. Many of these impacts are listed on page two of the application. You should mark all of those financial impacts that apply to you or your family members. You should make this mark in the line before the description of the specific impact. Then write in the space labelled "Amount Claimed" the amount of that impact. Once you do this, you will need to attach to the application the proof of the financial impact. We have enclosed FAQs to help you understand NOK's CARES Act process.

As an example, if due to COVID 19 you and your spouse had to work from home in March, April and May 2020, and the result was that your utility costs were \$500 higher than in the same months in 2019, you should mark the space labelled "Increased Utilities costs due to working from home due to COVID-19" and write "\$500" in the space labelled "Amount Claimed." Then you will need to attach your utility bills from March, April and May 2019 and your utility bills for March, April and May 2020 to show that your utility costs were \$500 higher when you were working from home. If your total claim is less than \$500 you have the option of providing a written statement about your expenditures instead of the actual bills. This is explained in the application and the FAQs.

Your completed application should be mailed, emailed or hand delivered to NOK at 215 Mission Road, Suite 212, Kodiak, Alaska 99615. The deadline for submitting your application is 5:00 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on November 12, 2021. If your application is denied, there is an appeal process. Applications submitted after 5:00 p.m. AST on November 12, 2021 may be considered by NOK if CARES Act funds remain after decisions have been made upon applications submitted prior to the November 12 application deadline.

We recognize that the timeline regarding these CARES Act funds is very short, but this is necessary due to federal law which requires that funds must be properly disbursed by December 31, 2021 or the funds have to be returned to the government. NOK will do everything possible to process your completed application as quickly as we can and to pay approved claims promptly.
